# Apply to WSU



WSU is open enrollment, and there isn't an application deadline. High school students may apply beginning Sept. 1 of their senior year. if you have completed any WSU Concurrent Enrollment classes during high school, you do not need to reapply for admission.

# 1. FILL OUT THE application online

# 2. SUBMIT required documents

- A. Official high school transcript sent directly from the high school, or GED documentation. If students have completed 30 or more college credits, they do not need to submit a high school transcript.
- B. ACT/SAT scores. (These tests are not required for admission, but the scores will help determine scholarship eligibility, and math and English placement.)
- C. Official transcripts from all colleges or universities where the student has completed work (including Concurrent Enrollment). The transcripts must be sent directly from the colleges to the WSU Admissions Office.
- 3. PAY THE \$30 application fee

# **Concurrent Enrollment** STUDENTS: Get the Edge

If you have 12 or more WSU Concurrent Enrollment credits with a 3.0 GPA by the time you graduate high school, you may be eligible for the EDGE Scholarship.

# SENIORS: Status Switch

Weber State University has now made it easier for you to make the transition from a high school concurrent student to a fully admitted WSU student. You don't need to reapply for admission, simply follow these easy steps:

## Academic Scholarships

Academic scholarships are based on your index score (ACT/SAT + GPA).

#### Presidential-Aletheia Scholarship

- Four-year full tuition and general fees scholarship.
- Requires a minimum 128 index score
- Must maintain 3.75 WSU GPA and be full time (15-18 credits)

#### High Honors/Honors/Achievement Scholarships

- High honors: 120-127 index; \$2,800 per year.
- Honors: 115-119 index; \$1,800 per year.
- Achievement: 105-114 index; \$900 per year.
